India has said that the Nawaz Sharif-led Pak government has given "good signals" in normalising bilateral ties but cautioned against expecting "magic overnight".

External affairs minister Salman Khurshid said on Friday, "With the new government, good signals have been given by them. But I don't think we should expect magic overnight."
