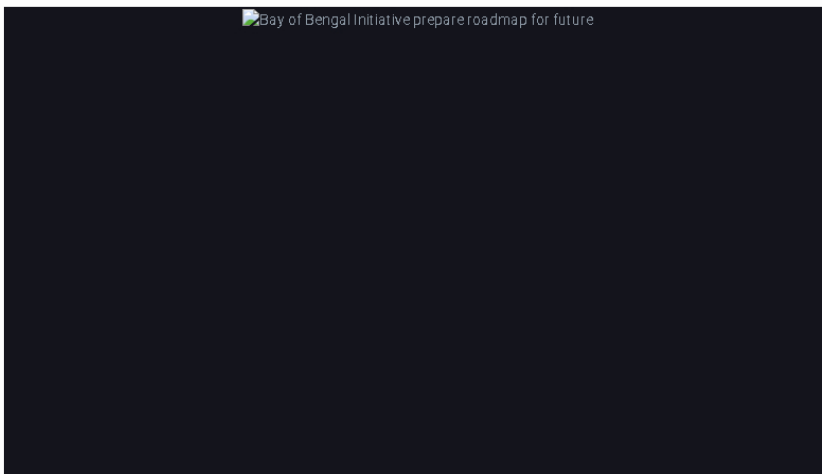


Bay of Bengal Initiative prepare roadmap for future
