Post	:	Professor on selection/deputation
Age limit	:	Not more than 50 years of age
Educational and other qualifications required	:	i) A high second class Post Graduate degree in Economics, from a recognized university; ii) Doctoral Degree in the relevant discipline iii) Fifteen years of experience in research and/or training in the field of international economics and, peer reviewed publications in developmental policies.

ASSOCIATE PROFESSOR

Post	:	Associate Professor on selection/deputation
Age limit	:	Not more than 50 years of age
Educational and other qualifications required	:	(i) Master' degree in Economics or a related discipline/operational research/Social Science (ii) Ph.D in Economics or a related discipline; (iii) Ten years of experience of relevant research in international economic issues out of which five years should be at a senior supervisory level.

ASSISTANT PROFESSOR

Post	:	Assistant Professor on selection/deputation
Age limit	:	Not more than 45 years of age (relaxable for SC/ST and others as per Government of India Rules)
Educational and other qualifications required	:	(i) Post Graduate degree in relevant discipline i.e. Economics/Public Administration/Statistics depending upon the field relevant to the post. (ii) Five years of experience in teaching/research/project formulation/monitoring and supervision in the relevant fields; (iii) Doctoral degree in the relevant discipline (Economics).

YOUNG PROFESSIONAL

Post	:	Young Professional
Age limit	:	Not more than 35 years of age
Educational and other qualifications required	:	(i) Master' degree in Economics (ii) Doctoral degree in the relevant discipline (Economics).

Note:

- (a) The appointing authority may, at its discretion, relax any of the conditions prescribed above, in favour of a candidate of exceptional merit on the basis of recommendations made by the Selection Committee.
- (b) Nothing in the above criteria shall affect reservations relaxation and other concessions required to be provided for the scheduled castes and scheduled tribes and other special categories of persons in accordance with the orders issued by the Central Government from time to time in this regard.
- (c) Interviews of the shortlisted candidates would be in virtual format. Details would be shared after receiving confirmation from the shortlisted candidates.

The service conditions of the selected candidates for the posts would be governed under the Bye Laws of RIS.
