## Applications for the post of Consultants at RIS

RIS is looking for young, dynamic and motivated research scholars for its evidence based research policy work programme in the field of agriculture, including, its collaborative project in this field for IFPRI as well as G20 issues.

### Essential Qualification:

- M.A in Economics from a reputed Indian or foreign university
- Ph.D in Agriculture Economics/Economics with experience in agriculture-related research studies for at least 3 to 5 years demonstrating sound knowledge in statistical and econometric techniques.
- Candidates having research experience in South Asian and BIMSTEC countries with some publications would be preferred.

**Role and responsibilities:** Reporting to the Project Lead on identification of research questions, formulation of hypotheses and preparation of data analysis reports covering agriculture trade products, food processing and their integration with regional supply chains, food safety and security issues, tariff and non-tariff measures, modeling of disaggregated granular data on exports and imports, etc.

**Remuneration:** Rs. 1,00,000/- per month, all inclusive

**Duration:** Initially, the appointment would be for a period of one year, including a probation of three months, on contractual basis. Continuation beyond this period would be subject to overall performance review.
